1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the Emergencies (Service Provider) Approval 2014 (No 5).

2 Commencement

This instrument commences 1 January 2015.

3 Approval

I approve **Southern Cross Motorsport Fire and Rescue** (the approved provider) to provide fire and rescue services (the services) at motor sports events in the ACT approved in writing by the Emergency Services Commissioner.

4 Conditions on Approval

The conditions in Schedule 1 apply to the approval.

5 Expiry

This instrument expires 6 January 2015.

SCHEDULE 1

Conditions on Southern Cross Motorsport Fire & Rescue for approval under section 62(4) of the *Emergencies Act 2004*

1. The approved provider may only perform the services within the geographical boundaries for the event specified by the approval referred to in Clause 3 of this instrument.
2. This instrument approves only the staff nominated by Southern Cross Motorsport Fire & Rescue in its application for approval under section 62 of the *Emergencies Act 2004*.
3. Staff not nominated by Southern Cross Motorsport Fire & Rescue in its application for approval under section 62 of the *Emergencies Act 2004* must be approved in writing by the Emergency Services Commissioner.
4. Southern Cross Motorsport Fire & Rescue must provide the Emergency Services Commissioner with copies of any updated or renewed insurance documentation if insurance is renewed or varied during the approval period.
5. Southern Cross Motorsport Fire & Rescue may only respond to low level fires including:
 - Rubbish bin fires;
 - Carburettor fires in vehicles;
 - Minor vehicle fires (rubber and transmission fires) during burn-out competition; and
 - Assist drivers from vehicles if the vehicle has stopped at the burn-out competition.
6. Southern Cross Motorsport Fire & Rescue may provide a fuel escort, escorting entrants with fuel containers to the fuel depot located within the geographical boundaries of the event where fuel is stored safely in a compound.
7. Southern Cross Motorsport Fire & Rescue may clean up oil or fuel spills on the cruise route at Exhibition Park in Canberra.
