**1 Name of instrument**

This instrument is the *Utilities (Technical Inspectors) Appointment 2014 (No 1)*.

**2 Appointment of temporary technical inspector**

## **SCHEDULE**

### **Name of person**

### **Conditions of appointment**

Peter Moltman

The powers given under this appointment are for the purposes of facilitating the auditing of hazardous area assessment of gas meter set installations.

The functions to be exercised under this appointment are limited to the following:

#### **Power to enter premises**

Section 154(1)(c) and (2) of the Utilities Act

The person appointed technical inspector by this instrument may enter premises to which the gas meter set distribution network is provided (but not any building used as a residence or dwelling) between the hours of 8 am and 5 pm, Monday to Friday.

#### **Powers while on premises**

Sections 164 and 159 (1)(a),(1)(c) and (1)(d) of the Utilities Act

The person appointed technical inspector by this instrument may:

- Inspect, measure, photograph or film gas distribution infrastructure on the premises (but not within any building used as a residence or dwelling); and
- Take into the premises (but not any building used as a residence or dwelling) any person(s), equipment or material reasonably needed for exercising a function under this instrument.

#### **Requirement to carry and produce identity cards**

Section 155 of the Utilities Act

The person appointed technical inspector by this instrument, and any person assisting the inspector:

- Must carry and produce on request his or her photographic identity card issued by ESDD - Construction Services, Utilities Technical Regulation Team.
- Must not remain on premises entered under this instrument if, on request by the occupier, the inspector does not produce his identity card.
