### 1 Name of approval

- 1. A person may be excluded for a period of time from entering a pool facility if the person:
  - a. has been given a direction by an authorised person under the *Public Pools*Act 2015 (the Act) to leave a pool facility; or
  - b. refused to leave a pool facility when directed to do so; or
  - c. within the last five (5) years committed an offence under the Act while at the pool facility; or
  - d. court action for an offence under the Act has not been finalised.
- 2. In deciding whether a person should be excluded from entering a pool facility a pool operator must consider:
  - a. the severity of the behaviour;
  - b. any previous behaviour or conduct while at the facility;
  - c. whether or not the behaviour or conduct affected other patrons at the facility; and
  - d. the likelihood of the person repeating the behaviour or conduct.
- 3. A pool operator is not to exclude a person from a pool facility for any period that exceeds 30 days.
- 4. If a pool operator seeks to exclude a person for longer than the period specified in clause 3, the operator must seek the approval of the Director-General by providing a written request detailing:
  - a. the reason why the exclusion period should be for a longer period; and
  - b. the time period sought for the exclusion.
- 5. A pool operator must not exceed the exclusion period authorised by the Director-General under clause 4.
- 6. A pool operator may reduce the exclusion period or revoke the exclusion at any time.
- 7. A pool operator must, as far as is reasonably practicable, provide written notice to a person if they are to be excluded. The notice must contain the following information:
  - a. the name of the person excluded;
  - b. the period of time that the person is excluded;
  - c. when the exclusion period is to, or did, commence;
  - d. the reason for the exclusion; and
  - e. information on the operator's complaint processes.
- 8. A pool operator must keep a record of all exclusions.
