1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Utilities Notice* (*Transfer of Licence*) 2015.

2 Public notice of licence decision – transfer of utility licence

The Independent Competition and Regulatory Commission (Commission) has agreed to transfer a utility licence from TransGrid (ABN: 19 622 755 774) to NSW Electricity Networks Operations Pty Limited as Trustee for the NSW Electricity Networks Operations Trust (ABN: 70 250 995 390) (licensee) to provide electricity transmission services in the ACT.

3 Licensed utility service

The transferred utility licence allows the licensee to provide electricity transmission services under section 6(d) of the *Utilities Act* 2000.

4 Date of effect of the transfer of licence

The transfer comes into effect on 16 December 2015. To avoid doubt, the licensee will hold a utility licence, and TransGrid will cease to hold a utility licence, upon the transfer coming into effect.
