1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Planning and Development (Draft Variation No 346) Public Availability Notice 2016.*

3 Effect of the draft plan variation

Section 72 of the *Planning and Development Act 2007* (the **Act**) does not apply in relation to the Draft Variation and therefore it does not have interim effect. The current Territory Plan will continue to apply while the Draft Variation remains in draft form.
