1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Emergencies (Service Provider) Approval 2016 (No 5)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after it is notified.

3 Approval

I approve FIRST AID AUSTRALIA PTY LTD trading as AMBULANCE SERVICE AUSTRALIA (the approved provider) to provide ambulance services (the services) at events in the ACT.

4 Conditions on Approval

Approval is subject to the conditions contained in Schedule 1.

5 Expiry

This instrument expires on 30 June 2017.

6 Revocation

This instrument revokes Emergencies (Service Provider) Approval 2015 (No 4) [NI2015-349].

SCHEDULE 1

CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

1. Ambulance Service Australia may only perform the services within the geographical boundaries of an approved event notified to the Chief Officer ACT Ambulance Service.
2. Ambulance Service Australia must not transport any person outside the geographical boundaries of event notified to the Chief Officer, ACT Ambulance Service.
3. This instrument approves only the staff nominated in the Ambulance Service Australia application for approval under Section 62 of the *Emergencies Act 2004*.
4. Staff of Ambulance Service Australia who are not notified to the Chief Officer ACT Ambulance Service in the original application may only provide services after the date of the instrument once notified in writing to the Chief Officer ACT Ambulance Service.
5. Ambulance Service Australia must provide copies of any updated or renewed insurance documentation if insurance is renewed during the approval period.
6. Ambulance Service Australia must provide the Chief Officer ACT Ambulance Service copies of any clinical or pharmaceutical management guidelines implemented during the approval period.
