1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the Legislation (Emergencies) Delegation 2018 (No 1).

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after it is signed.

3 Definitions

In this instrument:

emergency plan means the emergency plan for the ACT as made under Section 147 of the *Emergencies Act 2004*.

sub-plan means a plan under the emergency plan dealing with a specific hazard that is reasonably likely to occur in the ACT as described in section 148 of the *Emergencies Act 2004*, and other supporting, recovery and coordination plans under the emergency plan but does not include any plans relating to national security or the Community Communication and Information Plan as outlined in section 149 of the *Emergencies Act 2004*.

4 Revocation of functions

I revoke any prior delegation made in relation to the emergency plan.

5 Delegation of functions

I delegate each function identified in column 2 in schedule 1 (subject to any limitation expressed in column 3 of the same row in schedule 1) to the Director-General of the Justice and Community Safety Directorate.
