1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Victims of Crime (Financial Assistance)*(Appropriately Qualified non-government agencies) Guideline 2019 (No 1).

2 Commencement

3 Guideline

I hereby make the Guideline for Appropriately Qualified non-government agencies in accordance with section 87(1)(b) of the Act. The agencies that are appropriately qualified for reporting under section 31 (Application to commissioner) are set out in Schedule 1.

This instrument revokes *Victims of Crime (Financial Assistance)* (Appropriately Qualified non-government agencies) Guideline 2016 (No 2).
