Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulation 2017, section 14 (Approval of police vehicle speedometers)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Police Vehicle Speedometer Approval 2021*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 12 August 2021.

3 Approval

I approve the following speed measuring devices fitted to a vehicle driven by a police officer as a traffic offence detection devices

- a) Ballinger SDS Detector
- b) Ballinger SDSCAN
- c) Holden Commodore Police Pack Factory Speedometer
- d) BMW Factory Speedometer.

4 NSW Approved Devices

If a NSW police officer is appointed as a special member of the AFP, a NSW approved speed measuring device fitted to a vehicle driven by the NSW police officer, is approved as a traffic offence detection device.

5 Definitions

NSW approved speed measuring device means a device approved under section 134 of the *Road Transport Act 2013* (NSW).

police officer means a member or a special member of the Australian Federal Police.

speed measuring device—see section 22A of the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Act 1999*

traffic offence detection device—see section 23 of the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Act 1999*

6 Revocation

This instrument revokes *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Police Vehicle Speedometers Approval 2020 (No 2) NI2020-702*.
