### 1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Police Vehicle Speedometer Approval 2021.* 

## 2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 12 August 2021.

# 3 Approval

I approve the following speed measuring devices fitted to a vehicle driven by a police officer as a traffic offence detection devices

- a) Ballinger SDS Detector
- b) Ballinger SDSCAN
- c) Holden Commodore Police Pack Factory Speedometer
- d) BMW Factory Speedometer.

# 4 NSW Approved Devices

If a NSW police officer is appointed as a special member of the AFP, a NSW approved speed measuring device fitted to a vehicle driven by the NSW police officer, is approved as a traffic offence detection device.

### 5 Definitions

**NSW approved speed measuring device** means a device approved under section 134 of the *Road Transport Act 2013* (NSW).

*police officer* means a member or a special member of the Australian Federal Police.

**speed measuring device**—see section 22A of the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Act 1999* 

*traffic offence detection device*—see section 23 of the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Act 1999* 

# 6 Revocation

This instrument revokes *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Police Vehicle Speedometers Approval 2020 (No 2)* NI2020-702.
