Malkara School Age Care operated by Communities@Work is exempt from complying with *Children and Young People (ACT Childcare Services)* Standards 2009 (No 1) - 1.47 and 3.2

1.47 Staff qualifications

Positions requiring a qualified person must be filled by an adult who holds one of the qualifications listed under regulation 1.47 and 1.33 of the *ACT Childcare Services Standards*.

3.2 Qualified staff

The service must employ a minimum of one qualified staff member for every thirty three (or part thereof) children.

7 Explanation and Additional Conditions

The service is approved to operate with suitably skilled and experienced educators named in the application for this TSE to act in the qualified position at the service, who do not hold any of the qualifications prescribed in regulations 1.47 and 1.33.
