Electoral (Proposed Cancellation of Registration of Political Party – Small Business Australian Capital Territory) Notice 2023

Electoral Act 1992, s 98 (Cancellation of registration of political parties)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Electoral (Proposed Cancellation of Registration of Political Party – Small Business Australian Capital Territory) Notice 2023*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after notification.

3 Notice

I propose to cancel the registration of Small Business Australian Capital Territory in accordance with section 98 (5) of the *Electoral Act 1992*, on the grounds that the party does not have at least 100 members who are electors.

4 Objection

If you wish to object to this cancellation you are invited to lodge a written notice of objection with the Electoral Commissioner.

The notice should:

- set out the grounds of the objection; and
- set out the name and address of the objector; and
- be signed by the objector.
