

# Children and Young People (Childcare Service Licence) Temporary Standards Exemption 2023 (No 12)

## 1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Children and Young People (Childcare Service Licence) Temporary Standards Exemption 2023 (No 12)*.

## 2 Purpose of this Instrument

This instrument is to issue a *Temporary Standards Exemption* as specified in Section 749 (2) of the *Children and Young People Act 2008*.

## 3 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after notification.

## 4 Expiry

This instrument expires six (6) months after the day it commences.

## 6 Temporary Standard Exemption Standard

Duntroon Early Childhood Programs operated by Duntroon Community Services Inc is exempt from complying with Children and Young People (ACT Childcare Services) Standards 2009 (No 1) - 5.37

*5.37 – There must be a minimum of 7m<sup>2</sup> of unencumbered outdoor play space per child.*

## **7 Explanation and Additional Conditions**

This exemption enables the program to operate without a minimum of 7m<sup>2</sup> outdoor play space per child as specified in the application for this temporary standard exemption. The service is required to conduct daily excursions to the local park and has committed to engaging an additional educator to cover the ratio requirements.

Excursion authorisation and risk management plans have been put in place with families required to sign prior to first excursion. Additional planning time has been implemented to ensure that children's educational, social and developmental wellbeing is being supported and maintained. This exemption is valid for 4 months from the day it commences.
