1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Nature Conservation (Closed Reserves) Declaration* 2023 (No 6).

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day it is signed.

3 Declaration

I declare that public access to:

- (a) the reserve listed in schedule 1; and
- (b) the parts of Mount Majura Nature Reserve indicated as Hackett Horse Paddock in the map at schedule 2

is prohibited during the periods specified in schedule 3 (*closure periods*).

4 Exceptions

Section 3 does not apply to:

- (a) a conservation officer exercising a function under the Act; or
- (b) a person accompanied by a conservation officer exercising a function under the Act; or
- (c) a contractor undertaking rabbit control work within the closed reserves and engaged by the ACT Government to do so.

5 Definitions

Closed reserves means the reserves mentioned in schedule 1 and schedule 2.

6 Expiry

This instrument expires on 1 March 2024.
