1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Victims of Crime (Financial Assistance) (Appropriately qualified non-government agencies) Guideline 2025 (No 1)*.

I hereby make the Guideline for appropriately qualified non-government agencies in accordance with section 87(1)(b) of the Act. The agencies that are appropriately qualified for reporting under section 31 (Application to commissioner) are set out in Schedule 1.
