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## 1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Medicines, Poisons and Therapeutic Goods (Regulated Substances and Therapeutic Goods) Authorisation 2025 (No 1)*.

## 2 Commencement

## 3 Authorisation

I authorise a public employee identified in schedule 1 column 1, to deal with a regulated substance or regulated therapeutic good identified in column 2 in accordance with a standing order issued by the Chief Health Officer under s 77 (*Authorisation of CHO to issue standing orders for supply and administration of medicines at walk-in centre—Act, s 42 (b)*) in relation to the regulated substance or regulated therapeutic good.

## 4 Expiry

This instrument expires 2 years after the day it is notified.
