THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

No. 5 of 1930.

AN ORDINANCE

Relating to the Administration of the Territory for the Seat of Government.

B E it ordained by the Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909 and the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910, as follows:—

1.—This Ordinance may be cited as the Seat of Government Short title. (Administration) Ordinance 1930.

2. This Ordinance shall commence on the date of the com-commencement mencement of the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1930.

3. In this Ordinance, unless the contrary intention appears, Definition. "the Commission" means the Federal Capital Commission established under the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1924-1928.

4.—(1.) In any Ordinance in force at the commencement of References to the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1930—

(a) any reference to property or rights of property of, or forfeitures to, the Commission shall be read as property or rights of property of, or forfeitures to, the Commonwealth:

(b) any reference to officers or employees of, or employment by, the Commission shall be read as officers or employees of, or employment by the Commonwealth;

(c) any reference to a representative of the Commission in relation to any industrial matter shall be read as a reference to a representative of the Department of State for Works and Railways;

(d) any reference to the Secretary to the Commission shall be read as a reference to the Secretary of the Department of State administering that Ordinance;

- (e) any reference to any specified officer of the Commission (other than the Secretary) shall be read as a reference to such person as the Minister directs;
- (f) any reference to any office of the Commission shall be read as a reference to such office as the Minister directs;
- (g) any power or function vested in the Commission and exercisable by it, subject to the approval of the Minister, may be so exercised by the Secretary, Department of State for Home Affairs by the order and subject to the approval of the Minister;
- (h) any reference to the Chief Commissioner or Chairman of the Commission shall be read as a reference to the Secretary of the Department of State administering the Ordinance;
- (i) any reference to the Commission in the heading to any form therein shall be omitted;
- (j) any reference to "Home and Territories" shall be read as a reference to "Home Affairs".
- (2.) Where, in any Ordinance in force at the commencement of the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1930, any act of the Commission is required to be evidenced or done by or under the seal of the Commission, the act may be evidenced or done by writing under the hand of the Minister or such person as the Minister directs.
- (3.) Subject to sub-sections (1.) and (2.) of this section the powers and functions exercisable by, and anything required to be done by, to, or before the Commission under any such Ordinance, or any regulations made thereunder or under any instrument executed under or in pursuance of any such Ordinance or regulation, shall be exercisable and may be done by, to, or before the Minister or such person as is thereto authorized in writing by the Minister, and any reference to the Commission in any such Ordinance or in any instrument made under or in pursuance of any such Ordinance (including rules, regulations or by-laws) shall be read as a reference to the Minister.
- (4.) Any such Ordinance or regulation under such an Ordinance which contains a definition of the expression "Federal Capital Commission" or "the Commission" is amended by omitting that definition.
- (5.) Where any such Ordinance confers power upon any authority other than a Minister to make regulations under that Ordinance, that power shall be exercisable by a Minister.

Consequential Amendments.

5. Notwithstanding the provisions of the last preceding section, the Ordinances specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Ordinance are amended as respectively specified in the second column of that Schedule.

- 6. The Ordinances, the titles of which are specified in Column Administration of Ordinances. 1 of the Second, Third, Fourth and Fifth Schedules to this Ordinance, shall, to the extent specified in Column 2 of those Schedules, be administered respectively by—

 - (a) the Attorney-General's Department;
 - (b) the Department of Health;
 - (c) the Department of Home Affairs; and
 - (d) the Department of Works and Railways.
- 7. All the powers and functions exercisable by and anything References required to be done by, to or before the Administrator under any Administrator. Ordinance mentioned in the Second Schedule to the Federal Capital Commission's Powers Ordinance 1924-1925 or under any regulation made under any such Ordinance or under any instrument executed under or in pursuance of any such Ordinance or regulation shall be exercisable by and done by, to or before the Minister or such person as is thereto authorized in writing by the Minister and any reference to the Administrator in any such Ordinance, regulation or instrument shall be deemed to be a reference to the Minister.
- 8. The Delegation of Authority Ordinance 1923 and the Board of Inquiry Ordinance 1928 are repealed.
