# AN ORDINANCE

## Relating to the Term of Office of elected members of the Advisory Council.

B E it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Apprentic and the Commonwealth of Ap monwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Seat of Government Acceptance Act 1909 and the Seat of Government (Administration) Act 1910-1931, as follows:—

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Advisory Council short title. Ordinance 1933.
- 2. Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-section (4.) of Extension of term of office section four of the Advisory Council Ordinance 1930-1932, the office of elected persons elected in pursuance of that Ordinance as members of the Advisory Council and holding office at the commencement of this Ordinance shall, subject to the provisions of the Advisory Council Ordinance 1930-1932 continue to hold office until the eighteenth day of November, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-three.
