THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

No. 10 of 1933.

AN ORDINANCE

**Relating to the Term of Office of elected members of
the Advisory Council.**

BE it ordained by the Governor-General in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government Acceptance Act* 1909 and the *Seat of Government (Administration) Act* 1910-1931, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Advisory Council* Short title.
Ordinance 1933.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-section (4.) of section four of the *Advisory Council Ordinance* 1930-1932, the persons elected in pursuance of that Ordinance as members of the Advisory Council and holding office at the commencement of this Ordinance shall, subject to the provisions of the *Advisory Council Ordinance* 1930-1932 continue to hold office until the eighteenth day of November, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-three. Extension of term of office of elected members.
