**Poker Machine Control (Amendment)  
Ordinance 1981**

An Ordinance to amend the *Poker Machine Control Ordinance 1975*

**Short title**

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Poker Machine Control (Amendment) Ordinance 1981*.<sup>1</sup>

**Commencement**

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on such date as is fixed by the Minister of State for the Capital Territory by notice published in the *Gazette*.

**Principal Ordinance**

3. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Poker Machine Control Ordinance 1975*.<sup>2</sup>

**Trust account**

4. Section 42 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting "in the Territory" after "bank".

5. Sections 43 and 43A of the Principal Ordinance are repealed and the following section substituted:

**Payments for community purposes**

“43. The Board shall, not later than the fifteenth day of each month, pay to the Commonwealth for the purpose of the Australian Capital Territory Community Development Fund established as a Trust Account under section 62A of the *Audit Act* 1901 any money that was standing to the credit of the trust account referred to in section 42 on the fifteenth day of the preceding month.”

6. After section 45 of the Principal Ordinance the following section is inserted:

**Bank accounts**

“45A. (1) The Board may open and maintain an account or accounts at a bank or banks in the Territory, and shall at all times maintain at least one such account.

“(2) The Board shall pay all money received by it, other than money received by it from a club in pursuance of section 41, into an account referred to in this section.”

**Payment for community purposes from Board's trust account**

7. The Board shall forthwith pay to the Commonwealth for the purpose of the Australian Capital Territory Community Development Fund established as a Trust Account under section 62A of the *Audit Act* 1901 any money that was, immediately before the commencement of this Ordinance, standing to the credit of the trust account referred to in section 42 of the Principal Ordinance.
