An Ordinance to amend the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930*

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Seat of Government (Administration) (Amendment) Ordinance 1982*.¹

Principal Ordinance

2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930*.²

Administration of Ordinances

3. Section 10 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting sub-sections (5) and (6) and substituting the following sub-sections:

"(5) The *Stock Diseases Ordinance 1933* shall be administered by the Minister of State for Primary Industry.

"(6) Notwithstanding anything contained in this section, where, in a Part of the Second Schedule, a reference is made to a specified provision of an Ordinance, that provision shall be administered by the Minister of State by whom Ordinances specified in that part are administered."

Second Schedule

4. The Second Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is amended—
- (a) by omitting from Part 1—
“*Money Lenders Ordinance 1936*”; and
 - (b) by omitting from Part 2—
“*Stock Diseases Ordinance 1933*”.
