REGULATIONS UNDER THE REAL PROPERTY ORDINANCE 1924-1926.

Registrar of Titles (Office Hours) Regulations.

Short title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Registrar of Titles (Office Hours) Regulations.

Office hours.

2.—(1.) The hours during which the office of the Registrar shall be kept open daily throughout the year for the receipt of instruments purporting to deal with or affect any land under the provisions of the Real Property Ordinance 1925-1926 shall be as follows:—

Monday to Friday—10 a.m. to 12.30 p.m.; 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. Saturday—10 a.m. to 11.30 a.m.

(2.) The office of the Registrar shall not be kept open on Sundays. Christmas Day, Good Friday, the Saturday and the Monday after Good Friday, or on any day observed as a holiday in the offices of the Federal Capital Commission.
