AMENDMENT OF CANBERRA BUILDING REGULATIONS.

- 1. Regulation 3 of the Canberra Building Regulations is amended—
 (a) by omitting the words "the City Area"; and
 - (b) by adding at the end thereof the following sub-regulations:—
 - "(2) In the application of these Regulations outside the City Area, the Federal Capital Commission may in any case direct that the Regulations shall apply with such modifications and adaptations as the Federal Capital Commission thinks fit, and the Regulations shall thereupon apply in that case accordingly."

Bathrooms.

2. Regulation 48 of the Canberra Building Regulations is amended by inserting in sub-regulation (2) after the word "Bathrooms" the words "and water closets,"
