REGULATIONS UNDER THE BUILDING AND SERVICES ORDINANCE 1924-1925.

AMENDMENT OF CANBERRA ELECTRIC SUPPLY REGULATIONS.

Regulation 6 of the Canberra Electric Supply Regulations is repealed and the following regulation inserted in its stead:—

Charges.

"6.—(1.) The charges for the supply of electricity for power for industrial purposes shall be—

For each unit up to 500 units consumed in one

Where consumption per month is over 5,000 units

Such rate as the Commission determines

- "(2.) The charges prescribed by the last preceding sub-regulation shall apply, as regards any particular person, in respect of all electricity consumed by that person since the last reading made before the sixth day of August, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven of the meter installed for the registration of the amount of electricity consumed by that person.
- "(3) The charges for the supply of electricity for domestic purposes consumed on and after the first day of May, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven shall be—
