Amendment of Leases Regulations 1919.

- 1. Regulation 8 of the Leases Regulations 1919 is repealed, and the following Regulation is inserted in its stead:—
 - "8. No person shall hold under lease land of a greater assessed value than £8,000 (exclusive of the value of buildings, fences, dams, ground tanks, wells, and bores.)
 - 'Assessed value' for the purposes of this Regulation shall mean the assessed value as at the date of commencement of the lease.
