

THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

Regulations under the Meat Ordinance 1931.

I JOHN McNEILL, Minister of State for Health, acting for and on behalf of the Minister of State for Home Affairs, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930*, and the *Meat Ordinance 1931*, hereby make the following Regulations to come into operation forthwith.

MEAT REGULATIONS.

The Meat Regulations 1931 are amended by the addition of the following sub-clause to clause five:—

“(6) Any permit to slaughter issued under these regulations before 31st December, 1931, may be issued as having effect until 31st December, 1932, upon payment of a single fee of Two pounds in respect of such permit.”
