

THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

Regulations under the Companies Ordinance 1931.

I, ALEXANDER JOHN McLACHLAN, Vice-President of the Federal Executive Council, acting for and on behalf of the Attorney-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the *Companies Ordinance 1931*, hereby make the following Regulation to come into operation on and from the date of the commencement of the *Companies Ordinance 1931*.

AMENDMENT OF THE COMPANIES REGULATIONS.

The Schedule to the Companies Regulations is amended—

- (a) by omitting the figures "100" from Item 2 and inserting in their stead the figures "20";
- (b) by omitting the figures "40" from Item 4 and inserting in their stead the figures "20";
- (c) by omitting the figures "25" from Item 9 and inserting in their stead the figures "20"; and
- (d) by adding at the end of that Item the following proviso:—

"Provided also that in no case shall the maximum fees for registration whether in respect of capital as originally stated, or as increased, exceed £20."
