INSTRUMENTS REGULATIONS.

Short title.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Instruments Regulations.

Fee.

2. The fee for searching the Register of Agreements kept under Part IV. of the *Instruments Ordinance* 1933 shall be, in respect of each name, the sum of One shilling.
