AMENDMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH (BOARDING HOUSES) REGULATIONS.

1. Regulation 5 of the Public Health (Boarding Houses) Regulations is amended---

(a) by omitting from sub-regulation (1) the words "and forward therewith an application fee of Ten shillings";
and

(b) by omitting from sub-regulation (5) the words "and pay a renewal fee therefor of Ten shillings".

2: The Schedule to the Public Health (Boarding Houses) Regulations is amended by omitting from Form A the words "The registration fee of 10s. is forwarded herewith in the form of cash, cheque, postal note.",
