

Regulations under the Plant Diseases Ordinance 1934-1938.

AMENDMENT OF PLANT DISEASES REGULATIONS.

1. Regulation 27 of the Plant Diseases Regulations is amended by omitting the words "together with a fee of one shilling". Method of registration.
2. Regulation 29 of the Plant Diseases Regulations is amended by omitting the words "together with the prescribed fee". Certificate of registration.
3. Regulation 31 of the Plant Diseases Regulations is amended by omitting the words "and shall forward with the application a renewal fee of one shilling". Renewal of certificates of registration.
4. The Fourth Schedule to the Plant Diseases Regulations is amended by omitting the words "and enclose herewith the sum of in payment of the fee of registration". Amendment of Fourth Schedule.
5. Any fee forwarded with an application for the registration of an orchard or nursery, whether before or after the commencement of these Regulations, shall be refunded to person making the application. Refund of registration fees.
