### AMENDMENT OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH (SALE OF FOOD AND DRUGS) REGULATIONS.

After regulation 106 of the Public Health (Sale of Food and Drugs) Regulations the following regulation is inserted:—

“106A.—(1.) In any proceedings under these Regulations against **Evidence.** any person, the presence on or in his premises of any food or drug shall be *prima facie* evidence that the food or drug is in his possession for sale and that he has exposed or offered that food or drug for sale.”
