### Regulation under the Cemeteries Ordinance 1933-1942.

### AMENDMENT OF CANBERRA PUBLIC CEMETERY REGULATIONS.

After regulation 24 of the Canberra Public Cemetery Regulations the following regulation is inserted:—

“24A. Notwithstanding anything contained in the last preceding regulation, not more than one body shall be buried in any allotment specially set apart in pursuance of paragraph (c) of sub-section (1.) of section 5 of the *Cemeteries Ordinance 1933-1942*.”

One burial only in any allotment set apart for deceased members of Forces.
