Regulations 1949. No. 4.*

Regulations under the Building and Services Ordinance 1924-1942.

I HERBERT VICTOR JOHNSON, Minister of State for the Interior, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Building and Services Ordinance 1924-1942*, hereby make the following Regulations.

AMENDMENTS OF CANBERRA BUILDING REGULATIONS.

1. Regulation 32 of the Canberra Building Regulations is repealed and the following regulation inserted in its stead:—

“32. Every habitable room shall have a cubic space of not less than 720 cubic feet measured below 8 feet in height, and in each dwelling house and in each flat there shall be at least one habitable room the cubic space of which shall be not less than 1,152 cubic feet measured below 8 feet in height.”

Size of rooms.

2. Regulation 33 of the Canberra Building Regulations is amended by omitting the figure “9” (wherever occurring) and inserting in its stead the figure “8”.

Height of rooms.

3. Regulation 35 of the Canberra Building Regulations is amended by omitting from sub-regulation (1.) the figures “900” and inserting in their stead the figures “720”.

Lighting and ventilation.
