Regulation under the Public Health Ordinance 1928-1951.*

AMENDMENT OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH (SALE OF FOOD AND DRUGS) REGULATIONS.

1. Regulation 65 of the Public Health (Sale of Food and Drugs) Regulations is amended by omitting sub-regulation (1.) and inserting in its stead the following sub-regulation:—

“(1.) A person shall not sell ice-cream from a vehicle or have ice-cream on a vehicle under his control for the purpose of sale, unless—

- (a) he is the holder of a valid licence issued by the Director-General to sell ice-cream from a vehicle; and
- (b) the ice-cream is contained in a cardboard or similar container in which it was packed at the place of manufacture.”
