## Regulations 1952. No. 8.\*

### Regulations under the Building and Services Ordinance 1924-1942.

I WILFRED SELWYN KENT HUGHES, Minister of State for the Interior, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Building and Services Ordinance 1924-1942*, hereby make the following Regulations.

#### AMENDMENTS OF THE GARBAGE REGULATIONS.

1. Regulation 4 of the Garbage Regulations is amended by inserting in sub-regulation (1), after the word "Minister", the words "or an authorized officer". Segregation of wet garbage from dry garbage.
2. Regulation 5 of the Garbage Regulations is amended by inserting after the word "Minister" the words "or an authorized officer". All garbage to be placed in receptacles. ✓
3. Regulation 6 of the Garbage Regulations is amended by inserting after the word "Minister" the words "or an authorized officer". Grease traps.
4. Regulation 9 of the Garbage Regulations is amended by inserting in sub-regulation (1), after the word "Minister" (second occurring), the words "or an authorized officer". Weekly clearance of garbage from premises. ✓
5. After regulation 10 of the Garbage Regulations the following regulation is inserted:—  
"10A. Notwithstanding any other provision in these Regulations, the Minister may, at the request of the occupier of premises, arrange for the removal of garbage from those premises at such times, on such terms and on the payment of such charges as are agreed upon between the Minister and the occupier." Special arrangements for garbage removal. ✓
