## Amendments of the Garbage Requlations.

1. Regulation 4 of the Garbage Regulations is amended by inserting segregation or in sub-regulation (1), after the word "Minister", the words "or an wet marbage authorized officer ".
2. Regulation 5 of the Garbage Regulations i.: anended by inserting angarbage to after the word "Minister" the words " or an authorized officer". $\begin{gathered}\text { be papecdin } \\ \text { receptacles. }\end{gathered}$
3. Regulation 6 of the Garbage Regulations is amended by inserting Grease traps. after the word "Minister" the words " or an authorized officer".
4. Regulation 9 of the Garbage Regulations is amended by inserting weekly in sub-regulation (1), after the word "Minister" (second occurring), clearanere of the words " or an authorized officer".
5. After regulation 10 of the Garbage Regulations the following regulation is inserted:-
"10A. Notwithstanding any other provision in these Regulations, special the Minister may, at the request of the occupier of premises, arrange $\begin{gathered}\text { arrangement } \\ \text { for } \\ \text { garbage }\end{gathered}$ for the removal of garbage from those premises at such times, on such remoral. terms and on the payment of such charges as are agreed upon between the Minister and the occupier.".
