## AMENDMENT OF THE MOTOR TRAFFIC REGULATIONS.

The Second Schedule to the Motor Traffic Regulations is amended— The Second

(a) by omitting all the words from and including the word Parking "Franklin-street." to and including the words "grass" plots of Franklin-street."; and

(b) by omitting all the words from and including the words "CITY SHOPPING CENTRE" to and including the words "the western boundary of West Row.".
