Regulations under the Building and Services Ordinance 1924-1942.*

AMENDMENTS OF THE CANBERRA AND JERVIS BAY ELECTRIC SUPPLY REGULATIONS.

1. Regulation 6A of the Canberra and Jervis Bay Electric Supply Regulations is amended—

- (a) by omitting from paragraph (b) of sub-regulation (2.) the figures and words "1½d. per unit" and inserting in their stead the figures and words "3d. per unit"; and
- (b) by omitting from paragraph (b) of sub-regulation (4.) the figures and words "1½d. per unit" and inserting in their stead the figures and words "3d. per unit".

Charges for domestic, church, commercial, rural and motion picture premises.

2. The charges for the supply of electricity prescribed by regulation 6A of the Canberra and Jervis Bay Electric Supply Regulations, as amended by these Regulations, shall be payable in respect of the supply to a person of all electricity recorded by any reading, made after the date on which these Regulations are notified in the *Gazette*, of the meter or meters used for the purpose of ascertaining the quantity of electricity supplied to that person.
