Regulations under the Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1938-1952.*

AMENDMENTS OF THE CANBERRA COMMUNITY HOSPITAL (CHARGES) REGULATIONS.†

1. Regulation 8 of the Canberra Community Hospital (Charges) Regulations is amended by inserting after sub-regulation (1.) the following sub-regulation:—

“(1A.) The charge for a course of treatment by superficial skin therapy provided for an out-patient or a person to whom the next succeeding regulation applies is Five shillings for each visit.”

2. Regulation 9 of the Canberra Community Hospital (Charges) Regulations is amended by omitting from paragraph (c) of sub-regulation (2.) the words “the course of treatment specified in sub-regulation (1.)” and inserting in their stead the words “a course of treatment specified in sub-regulation (1.) or sub-regulation (1A.)”.
