## Regulations 1955. No. 7.

### Regulation under the Public Health Ordinance 1928-1951.\*

I, EARLE PAGE, Minister of State for Health, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Public Health Ordinance 1928-1951*, hereby make the following Regulation.

#### AMENDMENT OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH (GENERAL SANITATION) REGULATIONS.†

Regulation 20 of the Public Health (General Sanitation) Regulations is amended by adding at the end thereof the following sub-regulations:—

“(2.) A person shall not deposit, or cause or permit to be deposited, any rubbish or organic refuse (including human excrement) in the Cotter River Catchment Area otherwise than in an approved receptacle.

“(3.) Nothing in the last preceding sub-regulation interferes with or restricts the grazing or depasturing of animals.

“(4.) In this regulation ‘the Cotter River Catchment Area’ means the area described in the First Schedule to the *Cotter River Ordinance 1914-1938*.”
