## Regulations 1958. No. 13.

### Regulations under the *Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1938-1958*.\*

#### AMENDMENT OF THE CANBERRA COMMUNITY HOSPITAL (CHARGES) REGULATIONS.†

1. These Regulations shall come into operation on the first day of January, 1959. Commence-  
ment.

2. Regulation 5 of the Canberra Community Hospital (Charges) Regulations is amended by omitting sub-regulation (1.) and inserting in its stead the following sub-regulation:— Charges for  
in-patients.

“(1.) Subject to regulation 9 of these Regulations, the charge for treatment provided by the Board for an in-patient is at the rate of—

- (a) One pound sixteen shillings per day in respect of an in-patient in a general ward;
- (b) Two pounds fourteen shillings per day in respect of an in-patient in an intermediate ward; and
- (c) Three pounds twelve shillings per day in respect of an in-patient in a private ward.”.
