Regulations under the Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1938-1958.*

Amendment of the Canberra Community Hospital (Charges) Regulations.†

- 1. These Regulations shall come into operation on the first day of Commence-January, 1959.
- 2. Regulation 5 of the Canberra Community Hospital (Charges) Regu-Charges for lations is amended by omitting sub-regulation (1.) and inserting in its stead in-patients. the following sub-regulation:—
- "(1.) Subject to regulation 9 of these Regulations, the charge for treatment provided by the Board for an in-patient is at the rate of—
 - (a) One pound sixteen shillings per day in respect of an in-patient in a general ward;
 - (b) Two pounds fourteen shillings per day in respect of an inpatient in an intermediate ward; and
 - (c) Three pounds twelve shillings per day in respect of an inpatient in a private ward.".
