Regulation under the *Leases Ordinance* 1918-1958.*

AMENDMENT OF THE LEASES REGULATIONS 1929.†

After regulation 5 of the Leases Regulations 1929 the following regulation is inserted:—

“5A.—(1.) The period for which a lease may be granted for grazing, Period of lease. fruit-growing, horticultural, dairying or agricultural purposes is a period not exceeding fifty years.

“(2.) The period for which a lease may be granted for a purpose other than a purpose specified in the last preceding sub-regulation is a period not exceeding ninety-nine years.”
