FISH PROTECTION REGULATIONS.*

REGULATIONS 1960. No. 6.†

Regulation 9 of the Fish Protection Regulations is amended by omitting from table (2.) in sub-regulation (1.) the words and figures—

“ Australian Bass (Eastern ‘ Freshwater ’ Perch)	<i>Percalates novemaculeatus</i> ..	9
Goldern Perch or Yellow- belly	<i>Plectroplites macquariensis</i> ..	11

and inserting in their stead the words and figures—

Macquarie (or Mountain) Perch	<i>Macquaria australasica</i> ..	10
Murray or Trout Cod ..	<i>Maccullochella macquariensis</i>	21”.
