Regulation 10 of the Public Health (Sale of Food and Drugs) Regulations is amended by inserting after paragraph (d) the following paragraph:—

“(da) sells as food or as a drug goods containing extraneous matter that is inedible or likely to cause injury to a person if taken into his mouth;”
