REGULATIONS 1963. No. 1.*

Charges for in-patients.

1. Regulation 6 of the Canberra Community Hospital (Charges) Regulations is amended by omitting from paragraph (a) of sub-regulation (1.) the words "Two pounds four shillings" and inserting in their stead the words "Two pounds sixteen shillings".

Date as from which certain charges are payable. 2.—(1.) The rates of charges prescribed by sub-regulation (1.) of regulation 6 of the Canberra Community Hospital (Charges) Regulations as in force immediately before the commencement of these Regulations continue to apply—

- (a) in the case of a person admitted as an in-patient in an obstetric ward—up to and including the thirtieth day of September, 1963; and
- (b) in any other case—up to and including the thirty-first day of January, 1963.

(2.) The rates of charges prescribed by sub-regulation (1.) of regulation 6 of the Canberra Community Hospital (Charges) Regulations as amended by these Regulations apply—

- (a) in the case of a person admitted as an in-patient in an obstetric ward—on and after the first day of October, 1963; and
- (b) in any other case—on and after the first day of February, 1963.
