

REGULATIONS 1968, No. 9\*

1. These Rules shall come into operation on the date fixed under section 2 of the *Maintenance Ordinance* 1968.† Commencement.
  
2. Rule 50 of the Court of Petty Sessions Rules is repealed. Payment into Court in action by infant or person of unsound mind.
  
3. Rule 67 of the Court of Petty Sessions Rules is amended— Proceedings under New South Wales Acts continued in force in Territory.
  - (a) by omitting the words "*the Deserted Wives and Children Act, 1901*,"; and
  - (b) by omitting the words "*or the Infants Protection Act, 1904*,".
  
4. Notwithstanding the last preceding rule, the provisions of rule 67 of the Court of Petty Sessions Rules, as in force immediately before the commencement of these Rules, continue to apply to and in relation to proceedings under the *Deserted Wives and Children Act, 1901*, or the *Infants Protection Act, 1904*, of the State of New South Wales in their application in the Territory that were instituted before, and had not been completed before, the commencement of these Rules. Saving.
