## AMENDMENTS OF THE CANBERRA BUILDING REGULATIONS†

Regulation 71 of the Canberra Building Regulations is amended—

Penalties for offences.

- (a) by omitting from sub-regulation (2.) the words "Five pounds for the first offence, and Ten pounds for any subsequent offence," and inserting in their stead the words "Two hundred dollars"; and
- (b) by omitting from that sub-regulation the words "Ten shillings per day" and inserting in their stead the words "Ten dollars per day".
