#### AMENDMENTS OF THE TAXI AND PRIVATE HIRE CAR REGULATIONS†

Regulation 24 of the Taxi and Private Hire Car Regulations is amended— Taxi fares.

- (a) by omitting from sub-regulation (2.) the words "Twenty cents" and inserting in their stead the words "Twenty-two cents";
- (b) by omitting from sub-regulation (3.) the words "Twenty cents" and inserting in their stead the words "Twenty-five cents";
- (c) by omitting from sub-regulation (4.) the words "Fourteen cents" and inserting in their stead the words "Sixteen cents";
- (d) by omitting from sub-regulation (5.) the words "Fourteen cents" and inserting in their stead the words "Sixteen cents"; and
- (e) by omitting from sub-regulation (6.) the words "Twenty-five cents" and inserting in their stead the words "Thirty cents".
