

## Regulations 1975 No. 9

### Regulations under the *Cemeteries Ordinance* 1933-1966.\*

#### AMENDMENTS OF THE CANBERRA PUBLIC CEMETERY REGULATIONS†

1. Regulation 26 of the Canberra Public Cemetery Regulations is amended by inserting after sub-regulation (1) the following sub-regulation:—

Design and  
construction  
of monuments.

“(1A) A person shall not, in a lawn burial area, erect a tablet on which are inscribed more than 91 characters.”.

2. The Third Schedule to the Canberra Public Cemetery Regulations is amended by omitting item 13 and substituting the following item:—

Third Schedule.

“13. Supplying, inscribing and fixing a tablet in a lawn burial area . . 22.00”.
